

- **From Lake Mead Boulevard**

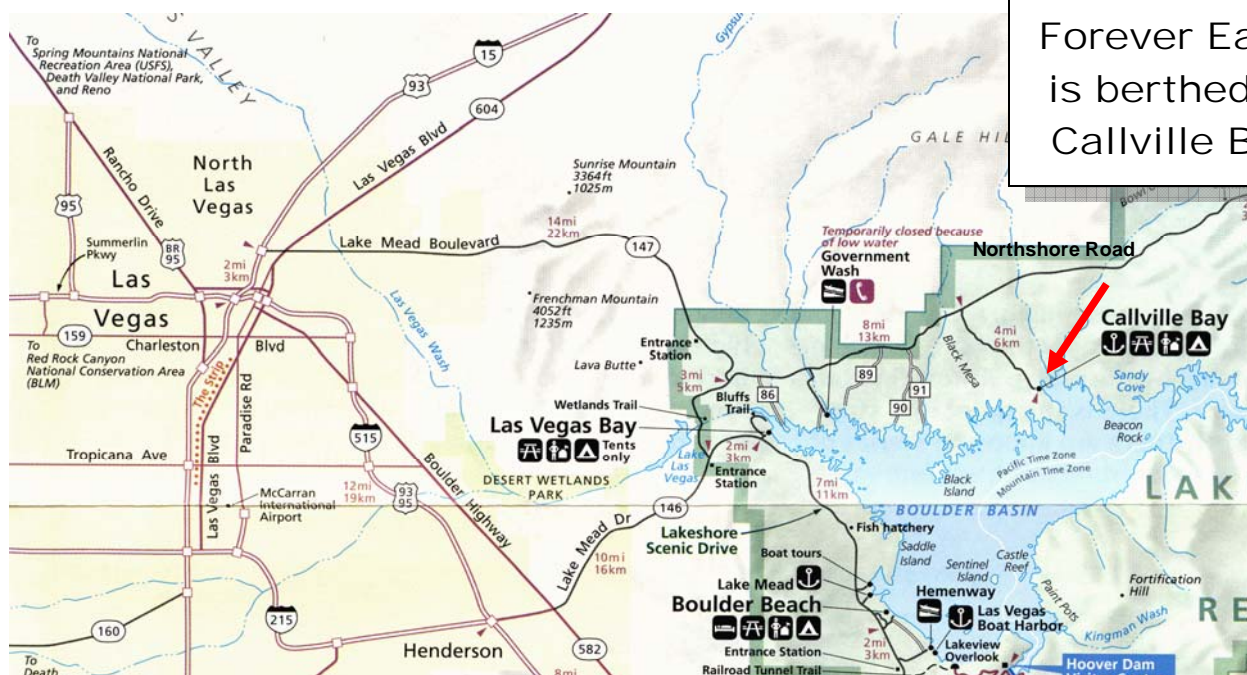
From Lake Mead Boulevard (Highway 147) go east to the Lake Mead National Recreation Area entrance station. Turn left on Northshore Road, and continue east for eight miles to the Callville Bay access road. You will see signs: Callville Bay ½ mile, Callville Bay ¼ mile. Follow the access road approximately four miles to Callville Bay Resort and Marina.

- **From Lake Mead Drive**

From Lake Mead Drive in Henderson (Highway 146) go east to the Lake Mead National Recreation Area entrance station. Turn left on Northshore Road, and continue heading north (three miles) and then east for eight miles to the Callville Bay access road. You will see signs: Callville Bay ½ mile, Callville Bay ¼ mile. Follow the access road approximately four miles to Callville Bay Resort and Marina.

- **From Boulder City**

From Boulder City follow Boulder Highway to Highway 93 (truck route) heading east to Lakeshore Scenic Drive. Turn left or north onto Lakeshore Scenic Drive to Lake Mead National Recreation Area entrance station, and continue approximately 11 miles. Turn right or north onto Northshore Road, and continue 11 miles to the Callville Bay access road. You will see signs: Callville Bay ½ mile, Callville Bay ¼ mile. Follow the access road approximately four miles to Callville Bay Resort and Marina.
