



Safety Information

A major consideration and priority of the Forever Earth program is the safety of its passengers.

The Forever Earth vessel is equipped with:

- first aid kits
- emissions detectors
- personal flotation devices (PFDs)
- communication devices (cell phone, marine radio, bell and horn signaling)
- sonar

To ensure participant safety:

- each Forever Earth trip begins with a customized safety presentation
- the program strictly adheres to a 25-passenger maximum capacity limit
- field trips and expeditions will be cancelled for any event that affects the safety of participants
- children ages 12 and under are required by law to wear the provided PFDs outside of Forever Earth's main cabin

In the unlikely event of a medical emergency, the Forever Earth Captain is to be notified immediately. The Captain will summon National Park Service emergency personnel via cell phone or radio.

Prior to the field trip, please assign the duty of contacting the emergency contact of any evacuated participant to a participating adult. Ensure that the chosen individual has a list of the emergency contact information for all participants on the day of the field trip.
